Notes from Mr. Sigwalt


- The Water Safety Course at the Hennepin Canal went very well. Participants spent a good amount of time in the water and the other time was spent discussing water safety tips.

- There are currently 64 kids signed up for the first session of camp. As of now, there is no cap on the number of kids, but one will likely be one added as the number continues to grow.
- We have started a counselor in training program for kids that are older. This will allow older kids to get experience in helping with a job while also still participating in camp.
- We are not currently accepting any more applications for summer positions, including day camp, concessions/admissions, or lifeguards.
